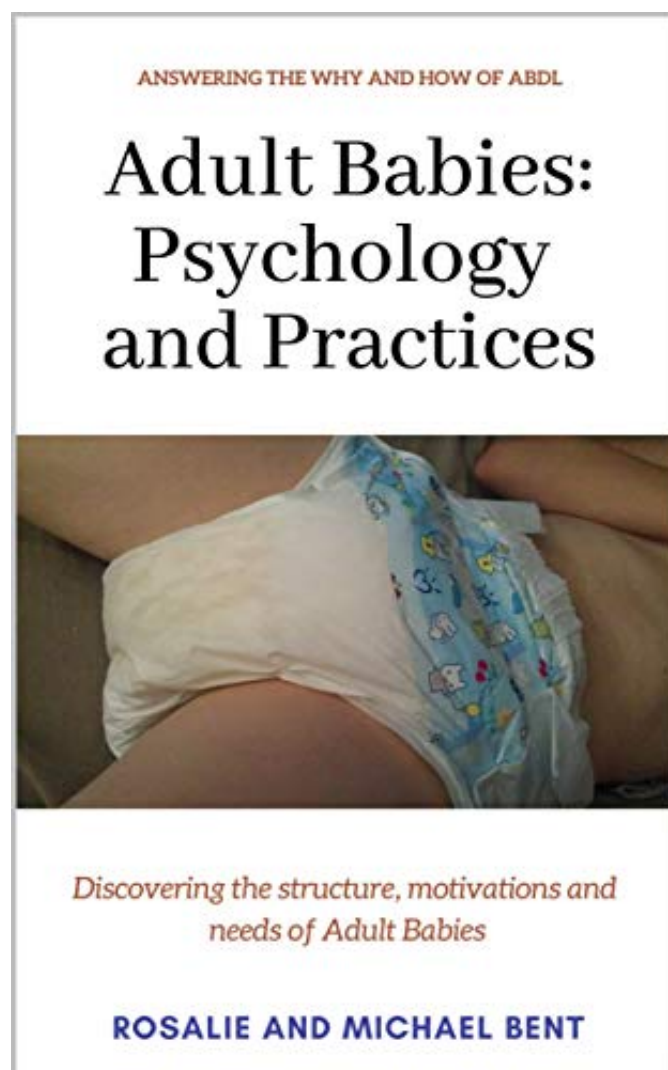


Adult Babies: Psychology and Practices: Discovering the structure, motivations and needs of Adult Babies
